Phonics

This term in phonics we will continue to learn the single sounds and some children may start to learn the sounds made by 2 or more letters. These are called our special friends- eg ay, ee, igh, ow, oo. Please read the books or ditty sheets with your child every night and sign the reading diary. Please also keep reading lots of bedtime stories so your child will want to read.





Literacy

During this term we will be sharing stories including, One snowy night, Gecko's Echo, Ridiculous and Mr. Wolf's Pancakes. The children will learn some new vocabulary and answer questions about the story. They will be writing short sentences and learning to use a full stop. Please encourage them to write at home.



Maths

In maths we will continue to use our subitising skills and recognise quantities on the 5 and 10 frames without counting. We will investigate 2 and 3D shapes, describing how many sides and corners they have. We will learn about addition and subtraction, recording our number sentences using the symbols + - =.



Understanding the world

During the term, we will be learning about Chinese new year and Easter. We will find out how different people celebrate these festivals, We will find out about freezing and melting and the different habitats that animals live in and look at maps of the world. We will also be taking part in the RSPB Big Garden Birdwatch on the 24-26 Jan!



Art and Music

We will sing lots of familiar songs and rhymes with the children, as well as listening and moving to different music. The children will also play percussion instruments. In Art we will learn about the artist Kandinsky and practice our colour mixing and drawing skills. We will experiment with styrofoam and rollers.



PE

In PE we will develop our balancing skills as we go on a train and circus adventure. We will use our travelling skills as well as developing our core muscles by practising different balances and use our yoga poses.
